Transfer to Hebrew-Speaking Programs

To transfer to Hebrew-speaking programs at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, or any other engineering faculty, students need to meet (1) Hebrew and (2) academic achievement requirements.

1. Academic achievement requirements

Transferring to a different faculty requires two semesters in TI. Whether or not a student can transfer to a faculty depends upon the requirements that that faculty has for academic achievement. Students are responsible for inquiring about the transfer requirements from the appropriate faculty. Students may also elect to take other courses that are not part of the international program in Mechanical Engineering (in their first academic year). It is important to note that if you do not transfer to the Hebrew program and you have not completed mechanical engineering courses, your graduation from TI will be delayed. This risk needs to be considered and is the responsibility of the student.

2. Hebrew requirements

Students in the English Mechanical Engineering program have three possible Hebrew study tracks. From these three tracks, only two allow transfer to the Hebrew program in Mechanical Engineering, or any other faculties. See flowchart for more details. Grade requirements are based on 2022 rules, and may change in different years. Please make sure to request updated current grade requirements from TI staff.
